I grew up loving horses, ponies and dogs and as a teenager I was able to purchase my own horse and started participating in show jumping.

In 1984 I purchased a bright bay section A colt from Jean Budler and my love of Welsh Ponies started - the colt was *Llandilo Philanderer* by *Twyford Splendour* out of *Bukkenburg Black Style*. Philly was cheeky and gorgeous and the idea of having a Welshie stud was born.

Braidwynn was the name of a Flatcoated Retriever kennel in the UK and I just loved the name.

I purchased my first mare *Aberdare Fantan* also from Jean, Fantan was by *Coed Coch Prydus* out of *Badgemore Gaylight*, she was a lovely chestnut mare with a flaxen mane and tail with a temperament to die for! She adored children and could often be found on the lawn dressed in all kinds of dress up clothes, she was in foal to *Bevlon Bachelor Boy (Cheeky Pep x Uyzel Silvia)* who was National Junior Champion the previous year.

In the beginning Robyn was a very nervous mare but she soon became very calm and gentle – probably the result of being hassled by 4 young children and their friends and a whole hoard of dogs, she probably decided that life was fun!

Robyn produced *Braidwynn Misty Morn* by Bachelor Boy. Misty was a beautiful little dark grey filly with the most exquisite head and temperament, she was born loving people. At 2 years of age she was the East Cape Regional Supreme Champion and a month later was Reserve National Junior Champion, that same year her mother Robyn was National Senior Champion mare.




Bukkenburg Bubble

Bukkenburg Bubble joined us and became our youngest daughter's lead rein pony. One of Bubble's daughters by Bundemar Hogigi, Braidwynn Belinda, also became an excellent child's pony.

Earlier I had purchased a partbred mare *Cornucopia All Aglow* from my brother in law, she had a beautiful grey filly foal at foot, *Braidwynn Lady Di*, she did very well in Young Child's classes with our daughter Kate. *Cornucopia All Aglow (Jinty)* produced another filly foal from the Arab stallion Jerico Nisim, *Braidwynn Rosy Flush* (Rosy) which was Kate's pony until she was 14. She was heartbroken to part with her.

Our eldest daughter bought herself a Partbred mare *Bukkenburg Linda* who was by the Cob stallion *Oak Hatch Flight* out of a partbred thoroughbred mare. Alli rode Linda for many years, even jumping her in adult show classes. Linda produced some lovely partbred foals *Braidwynn Touch of Class* by *Parc Crusader* and *Braidwynn Tailor Made* by the Russian Arab import Nafal (Taylor Made was put to sleep a couple of weeks ago at the age of 29).

Pippa then foaled to Bachelor Boy and Braidwynn Pipkin was born, a stunning grey filly who was the National Champion foal in 1992 under Judge Dr Wynne Davies. Prydferth produced *Braidwynn Sweet William (Billy)* by *Brackenwood Grey Bee*. Billy was a stunning liver chestnut. Everyone who met him loved him but unfortunately, we lost him to horse sickness at 4 years of age. He also was a National Junior Champion

Bukkenburg Daffydd (incorrectly registered as Bukkenburg Faffydd at SA Studbook) by Persie Nimrod out of Fronarth Gwenllian, and Bukkenburg Garnet by Persie Nimrod out of Bukkenburg Getha joined us. Both were Section C's.
