

## BELVOIR GAZANIA

This is the record of Gazania in the Welsh Pony and Cob Society, UK, Stud Book, Volume 44.

**19679 BELVOIR GAZANIA.** Cream, star and irregular stripe conjoined. Both fore and near hind hoofs half white. Foaled 1966. Height: Under 13.2. *Owner and Breeder*, Anne, Duchess of Rutland, Abbots Place, Putley, Nr. Ledbury. *Sire*: BROCKWELL BERWYN 3577. *Dam*: [Belvoir Zenobia No. 7980-F.S.2.] (Vol. XLIV), by BELVOIR GERVAS 2488.

It will be noticed that the mare Belvoir Zenobia is FS2, being out of Belvoir Zinnia FS1 out of Fairy Gold FS, a Part-Arab.

The Export Certificate was issued on 5 December, 1968, and she must have been in foal, the stallion not specified, because on 2 February, 1969, a filly foal was born dead. She attended her first Lowveld Show in 1969 and was placed 1<sup>st</sup> in the class for Brood Mare 14.2hh & under.

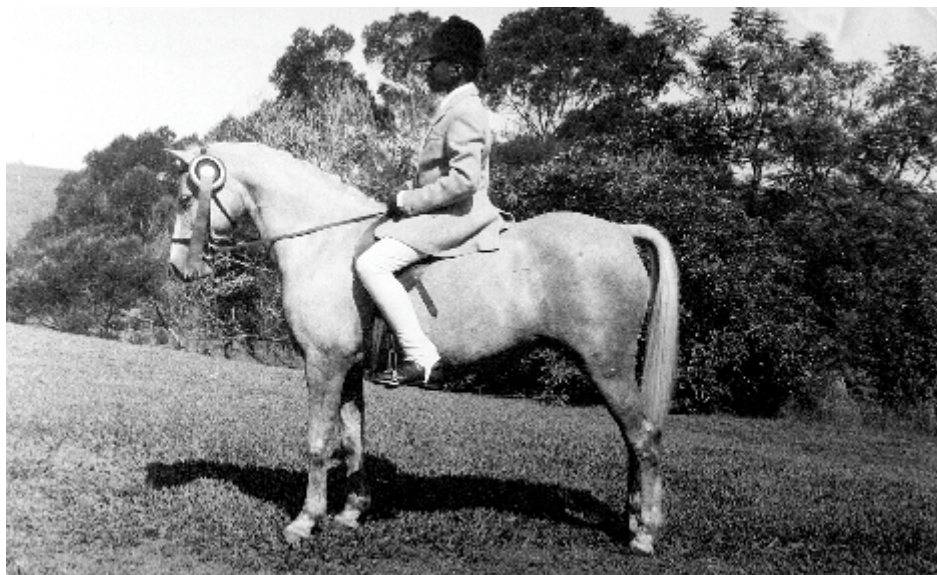
She was covered by Valiant and on 20 December, 1970, the filly Foresyte Valiant Gazelle was foaled. She went to three shows in 1971, the most important being the

Pretoria Show where she was 1<sup>st</sup> in the class Mare over 4 yrs, under 14.3hh. At the Rand Easter Show in 1972 she was the Champion Mare and in October she foaled Foresyte Cambrian Gardenia by Foresyte Valiant Cymro. 1973 saw the arrival of Foresyte Cambrian Golden Rod which was never registered as he died only a few months old. At the 1973 Rand Easter Show she was 3<sup>rd</sup> in the three classes she entered. Foresyte Merlin's Gilia by Foresyte Valiant Merli arrived in 1975 and Foresyte Cambrian Golden Gorse by Foresyte Valiant Cymro in 1976.

She missed two seasons and after being covered by Cymro was leased to Pat and Derek Moore (the Vet) of the Hydown Stud to foal down, and for William to ride/show. In July, 1979, Foresyte Cambrian Gazelle was foaled but never registered, for some unspecified reason. At the Hydown Stud, she was covered by Hydown Sparkleberry and Hydown Gooseberry, her only Partbred, was foaled in 1980.

Gazania only had two more foals, both by Bannut Larkspur; Foresyte Bannut Boy in 1982 and finally, Foresyte Bannut Golden Cloud in 1986.

Gazania's greatest success was under saddle with the highlight being winning the 1977 Indoor show with Lucas Chilwane on board.

Following on the list on the left was the Epol Indoor Horse Show in 1977 judged by Donald Owen. She was 1<sup>st</sup> in the class for Purebred Mare or Gelding under saddle with Lucas in the saddle. She was also 3<sup>rd</sup> in the class Registered Mare in Hand and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the class Open Pony Brood Mare under 13.2hh.

The 1978 Rand Show was to be her last Show. She was 1<sup>st</sup> in the class Purebred Welsh under saddle, 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Open pony Brood Mare under 13.2hh, 3<sup>rd</sup> in the class Working Welsh Pony under 1,40m, and 2<sup>nd</sup> under the Purebred Welsh In-Hand.

At this last show she was, however, awarded the Reserve Overall Championship for a Welsh Pony under saddle.
